The EGSAMP Summer School 2017 is organized in connection with the chair of Medieval Latin at the Institute for Greek and Latin Philology at the Free University of Berlin. The summer school will take palce at the Academy Berlin-Schmöckwitz (<u>https://www.akademie-schmoeckwitz.de/</u>) in the south of Berlin near the Zeuthener See (so we can have a swim - the water will be fine).

The summer school's topic "A Path Through the Ages. Philosophy and Doxography from Ancient to Early Modern Philosophy" reflects upon the relation between philosophy and its history, which must be understood from the very beginning of philosophy as an intrinsic and fundamental relationship rather than an accidental one which can be ignored.

The topic will be developed by distinguished invited speakers.

Moreover, PhD students and Postdoc fellows are invited to present their PhD and research projects – preferably in connection with the general topic. Participants will have the opportunity to discuss their ongoing research, enhance their competence in the various fields of editing and analysing philosophical texts and get helpful feedback regarding their projects by internationally renowned scholars.

Application requirements:

PhD students and Postdocs interested in taking part in the summer school are invited to send a CV and a short abstract (max. 300 words) of their proposed paper by **15** July.

All participants should submit their application by **30 July**.
