

With the programme “**a.r.t.e.s. international – for all**”, funded by the DAAD, the a.r.t.e.s. Graduate School for the Humanities Cologne – the integrated graduate school of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities – provides extensive funding to enhance the internationalisation of doctoral studies at the faculty. Applications for the following funding lines are possible:

OUTGOING

All doctoral students enrolled at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities are eligible to apply.

- Travel grants for **research stays** abroad
- Travel grants for **active conference participation** abroad
- Travel grants for **summer schools** abroad
- The **proofreading of doctoral dissertations** not written in the author’s native language
- Financial support for the organisation of **international doctoral workshops** in Cologne

INCOMING

International (prospective) doctoral students are eligible to apply. Applications may also be submitted by members of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities.

- Travel grants for **guest stays** at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities (max. three months)
- Travel grants for **familiarisation stays** at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities (max. two weeks)
- Travel grants for **active conference participation** at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities (max. five days)

Applications can be submitted at any time, and will be decided upon by the Grants Committee which meets four times a year. Please note that the deadline for the next meeting of the Grants Committee is **March 22, 2019**.
