

Guideline

Letter of recommendation regarding a scholarship for the preparation of a doctoral dissertation project

In the letter of recommendation, the authoring professor should ideally comment on the following aspects:

- Background of the applicant
- Academic performances
- Degree thesis (e.g. Master thesis), if the author has examined it
- Research proposal and work plan for the time period of the scholarship
- Potential of the applicant
- Overall assessment of the application
(on a scale of 1-10:
8-10 = strong recommendation,
5-7 = worth funding)

The letter of recommendation can be handed in by the applicant together with the rest of the application. Alternatively, it can be send via post to the following address:
